Selects some relevant examples which support viewpoint more consistently. 	<p>At the top of a pathway a student will: make more consistent valid evaluative and increasingly analytical comments on the text. Selects relevant examples which support viewpoint more consistently.</p> <p>At the bottom of the pathway a student will: begin to makes some more valid evaluative comments on the text. Begin to select an increasing number of relevant examples which support viewpoint more consistently.</p>
Pathway 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attempts to make some evaluative comments on the text. Attempts to use relevant examples which usually support viewpoint. 	<p>At the top of a pathway a student will: attempt to make some evaluative comments on the text. Attempt to use relevant examples which usually support viewpoint.</p> <p>At the bottom of the pathway a student will: have pathway 3 and will have started to use more relevant examples to support viewpoint.</p>
Pathway 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Makes simple evaluative comments on the text. Simple reference or textual detail used. 	<p>At the top of a pathway a student will: make simple evaluative comments on the text. Simple reference or textual detail used.</p> <p>At the bottom of the pathway a student will: make limited personal comments on the text which may explain viewpoint. Limited reference or textual detail used.</p>
