Week	Task	Extension
1	Choose a piece of music or a song and listen to it a couple of times. As you are listening, make a list of the musical elements and next to each one, say how it fits with your music. (Pitch, Duration, Dynamics, Tempo, Timbre, Texture and Structure)	Write your list into a descriptive paragraph
2	Find out some facts about the group/singer who performs the music that you listened to last week.	Get some pictures of your group or singer
3	Choose some more music by the same group/singer and compare it to the first one, using the elements. What is similar and what is different?	Which of your two pieces do you like the best-give reasons for your choice.
4	Put all your information together on a poster. This can be coloured in by hand or produced on the computer. It should have a bright, colourful title. Check List: Title First Song: Element list Second Song: Comparison Factfile on singer or group Put your name on	Present your work in a different way other than a poster. Check List: Title First Song: Descriptive paragraph on elements Second Song: Comparison and reasons for liking Factfile and pictures of singer or group Put your name on
5	A mnemonic is a way of helping you remember the meaning or the spelling of a word eg: RHYTHM= Rhythm Helps Your Two Hips Move Write a mnemonic to help you remember one of the elements	Write some mnemonics to help you remember the elements
6	Many of the words used in music are Italian. See if you can find out the meaning of these words: <i>Allegro</i> <i>Fortissimo</i> <i>Staccato</i> <i>Crescendo</i> <i>Vivace</i>	Find out the Italian words which mean the opposite of <i>Allegro</i> <i>Fortissimo</i> <i>Staccato</i> <i>Crescendo</i> <i>Vivace</i>
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
