This is a 3-year project funded by the EU with the aim of raising awareness of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) amongst teachers and young people in twelve European countries.

The project is co-funded by DEAR (Development Education and Awareness Raising) Programme of the European Commission.

The Get up and Goals Project is all about The 17 SDGs and has the objective of increasing pupil, teacher and community awareness of what these goals stand for and how they can help support positive changes in communities around the world. These 17 global goals are ambitious but working towards achieving these should help tackle global problems like hunger, climate change and gender inequality.

It is intended that through the use and development of these teaching resources that young people will be able to understand how they are 'interdependent', how the SDGs relate to all humans on the planet and that achieving these goals by 2030 is related to many everyday choices they make in their own lives. It can seem impossible that the average person can make an impact, but one of the aims of this project is to help young people understand how their future behaviour can make a positive difference to the world we share.
