We have spent a considerable amount of time updating our school website over the last year and I wanted to point out a few areas which may be of use to you and your child.

The Careers Education Information Advice and Guidance (CEIAG) section is useful for students across all years to access information regarding their future. There are sections for post-16 options including apprenticeships and other relevant information. There is also a Learn Live channel link here which allows students access to a wide range of information from a huge variety of employers; they can also ask questions if they wish.

It is important that you and your child are aware of Labour Market Information (LMI). If you are not familiar with this term it is details of jobs available, the requirements and role details, entry pathways and salaries. Years 8-11 have a Unifrog Account which is a careers platform they can use to prepare for their future. We will conduct some activities in school but they are able to use this independently whenever they wish. This page explains how the PD curriculum works and has links to our Relationships and Sex Education offer and to health and wellbeing links for any support you may require for either yourself or your child. There are other links which will be updated as necessary to show what has been going on in school and what the students have been involved in.

Whilst you are exploring these sections of the website, feel free to explore other areas of the site as there is a wealth of information available for you.

Can I also take this opportunity to remind parents of Year 11 students that open evenings and college/apprenticeship applications are available so please encourage your children to apply and ask for help from form tutors or myself. They will be having an interview with our careers adviser Alison Bellmon if they have not had one already.
